We follow a transparent admissions system and accept students into the School throughout the year. It is mandatory for the parents to meet our friendly admission crew and our School Principal in order to ensure that:


- The enrollment and other related forms, such as Students personality test form, Doctor's examination form are given to the parents, and are duly completed.


